Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the State.

The petitioners seeks bail in a case registered under Sections 25(1-b) a, 26, 35 of Arms Act.

As per prosecution case, on a tip off, police raided the house of Ramesh Yadav and apprehended the accused persons and recovered one country made pistol, two empty cartridges and one mobile from the possession of petitioner no.1 and two empty cartridges and one mobile from possession of petitioner no.2.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners have falsely been implicated in this case by the police due to ulterior motive. It is further submitted that nothing has been recovered from the possession of the petitioners. The petitioners have been languishing in custody since 30.03.2017.



Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, let, above named petitioners, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned C.J.M., Supaul in connection with jadiya P.S.Case No. 9/2017.
