2 20-07-2017 Apprehending their arrest in Natwar P. S. Case No. 81 of
2016 registered under sections 341, 323, 498-A and 302/34 IPC,
petitioners seek anticipatory bail.

The deceased is the daughter of the informant who died in the
matrimonial home 15 years after the marriage.

It is submitted that the victim was carrying advanced
pregnancy. She developed complication and was taken to the hospital,
but on the way she died. No external injury was found by the doctor on
her person. The rupture of the uterus and internal bleeding probably
caused the death of the victim. It is further stated that they are not
husband. The husband is morally and legally obliged to protect the wife
against any possible atrocity. Vide order dated 16.05.2017 (Annexure-2)
co-accused(s) Shankar Chaudhary and Chunmuna Devi, in the facts and
circumstances of the case, have been granted anticipatory bail.



Considering the submissions and the fact evidencing from the record, let the petitioners above named, in the event of arrest/surrender within four weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Bikramganj, Rohtas on condition that one of the bailors of each of the petitioners shall be their own/close family members.
