3 11-10-2017 The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with

Kotwali P.S. Case No. 252 of 2017, registered for offences

punishable under Section 365 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation is of kidnapping the mother of the informant

and later on dead body of the mother of the informant was found.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that he

has not been named in the F.I.R, his name surfaced in this case on

the confession of son –in-law of the deceased and except that there

is nothing against the petitioner so as to connect him with the

present occurrence. Further no incriminating article or anything

has been recovered and he has been in custody for last three

months and charge-sheet has been submitted.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.

Having heard both sides, in view of the above facts, let



the petitioner above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 25,000 (Rs. Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned CJM, Gaya, in connection with Kotwali P.S. Case No. 252 of 2017, subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) One of the bailors of the petitioner shall be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned Court.
- (ii) The petitioner will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence.
- (iii) The petitioner shall cooperate in the disposal of trial and make himself available as and when required by the court and on the event of failure on his part to appear before the court below on two consecutive dates without showing any genuine reasons, the prosecution is free to move for cancellation of his bail.
