3 01-09-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 304B, 120B/34 of the Indian
Penal Code in connection with Azamnagar P.S. Case No. 222/2016.

The petitioner is the husband of the deceased.

Submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner is
that there is no specific allegation against the petitioner. He has
falsely been implicated in this case.

Heard learned Additional Public Prosecutor also. He
opposed the prayer of bail and stated that asphyxia is result of
throttling.

Having heard both sides, in view of the facts, stated
above, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner, above named, on



bail. Accordingly, the same is rejected.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has remained in custody for one year, the trial court is directed to expedite the commitment of the case and try to conclude the trial within a period of nine months.

At the same time, S.P., Katihar is also directed to ensure the attendance of the witnesses so that the trial may be concluded within the stipulated period.
