ORAL ORDER

2 19-08-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the

State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for
offences under Sections 30 (a) and 38 of the Bihar Prohibition
and Excise (Amendment) Act, 2016.

It is contended that as per allegation, 265 pouches
each containing 200 ml, i.e., 53 litres of country-made liquor
were allegedly recovered from the possession of the petitioner.
Petitioner claims that he is having clean antecedent and is in
custody since 02.07.2017.

Considering the facts and the circumstances of the
case, the petitioner, above named is directed to be released on



bail on his furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Additional Sessions Judge-VII-cum-Special Judge, Aurangabad in connection with Narari Kala Khurd P.S. Case No. 27 of 2017 with a condition that if the petitioner, after his release in this case, is again found to be involved in criminal case of similar nature, the court concerned would be at liberty to take steps for cancellation of his bail bonds.
