2 18-09-2017 The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with

Madanpur P.S. Case No. 132 of 2017, registered for offences

punishable under Sections 30(A) of the Bihar Prohibition and

Excise Act, 2016.

Allegation is of recovery of 438 litres of country made
illicit liquor from a vehicle.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that he
has falsely been implicated in this case and he only happens to be
driver of the vehicle from which alleged recovery was made.
Further petitioner has no criminal antecedent and has been in
judicial custody since 12.06.2017.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.

Having heard both sides, considering the facts and



circumstances of the case and also that petitioner has no criminal antecedent has been in judicial custody for last more than three months, as such, let the petitioner above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 25,000 (Rs. Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Special Judge, Excise, Aurangabad, in connection with Madanpur P.S. Case No. 132 of 2017.

- (i) One of the bailors of the petitioner shall be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned Court.
- (ii) It is made clear that if the petitioner again found involved in any of the like offences, in future, prosecution will be free to move for cancellation of his bail bonds.
