ORAL ORDER

2 10-08-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for offence punishable under Sections 272, 273 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 30 (a)/47 of Bihar Excise Amendment Act, 2016.

It is contended that, as per allegation, 36 liters of country made liquor were recovered from a Tempo. The name of the petitioner has come in the confessional statement of the co-accused Manish Kumar, who has already been granted bail by a coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 24.05.2017 passed in Cr. Misc. No.23869. It is urged that the petitioner is in custody since 3.07.2017. It is claimed that his antecedent is clean.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner, above-named, is directed to be released on bail on



furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional District Judge, II, Sitamarhi in connection with Parsauni P.S. Case No.16/2017 with a condition that if the petitioner, after his release in this case, is again found involved in similar nature of cases then the concerned court would be at liberty to take steps for cancellation of his bail bonds.
