2 12-09-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

This is an application for bail in connection with Rohtas (Amjhor) P.S. Case No. 191 of 2017 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 30(a) and 34 of Bihar Excise Act.

Allegation against the petitioner is of recovery of 9.6 litres of country made liquor from his possession.

Submission of learned counsel for the petitioner is that he has falsely been implicated in this case and nothing has been recovered from his conscious possession and he is in custody for more than two months having no criminal antecedent.

Heard learned APP also.

Having heard both sides and in view of facts and circumstances, let petitioner, above named, be released on bail on



furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Additional Sessions Judge-II-cum-Special Judge, Excise Act, Rohtas at Sasaram, in connection with Rohtas (Amjhor) P.S. Case No. 191 of 2017, subject to the following conditions :-

- (1) One of the bailors shall be a local person having sufficient immovable properties within the jurisdiction of the court concerned,
- (2) Petitioner will co-operate in trial and appear in court on each and every date fixed in the case and on failure to appear without any genuine ground or without permission of court, his bail bond shall be cancelled.
