2 19-08-2017 Heard Sri Satya Prakash Parasar, learned counsel
for the petitioner and learned Addl. Public Prosecutor.

The sole petitioner, who is in custody since
27.06.2017 in Gidhaur(Laxmipur) P.S. Case No.116/17 registered
for the offence under Sections 272, 273 of the Indian Penal Code
and Sections 30(A)/37/41/45 of the Bihar Excise(Amendment)
Act,2016, has prayed for grant of bail.

It was submitted by learned counsel for the
petitioner that the petitioner was a passenger in a public carrier
vehicle, from which huge quantity of Indian Make Foreign Liquor
was recovered. He submits that the petitioner is having clean
antecedent, which fact has been stated in paragraph-3 of the
petition.

Considering the nature of accusation, clean



antecedent as well as period of custody, let the petitioner, namely, Harshvardhan Kumar be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M.3rd, Jamui in connection with Gidhaur (Laxmipur) P.S. Case No.116/17
