APP for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in connection with Atri P.S. Case
No. 175/2014 (G.R. No. 4654/2014) for offences punishable under
Sections 304-B/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The prosecution case, as lodged by the informant, is
that his daughter Gudiya Kumari @ Munni Devi was married to
co-accused Balchand Chaudhary in the year 2011 and was tortured
for non-fulfillment of demand of motorcycle by her husband and
the petitioner, who is the maternal uncle of her husband, and other
co-accused and ultimately she was burnt to death by all the
accused persons for non-fulfillment of demand of dowry.

It has been submitted by the learned counsel for the



petitioner that he is innocent, he has a separate home and hearth with that of the deceased and the allegation upon him is general and omnibus. He submits that he is the maternal uncle of the husband of the deceased and due to dirty village politics, he has been falsely implicated and is languishing in custody since 03.07.2017. It is further submitted that although during investigation case has not been found true but cognizance has been taken against the petitioner by the learned Magistrate.

However, learned APP for the State opposes the prayer for bail.

Considering the facts and circumstances and the materials on record, let petitioner, above named, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate-II, Gaya, in connection Atri P.S. Case No. 175/2014 (G.R. No. 4654/2014).
