There is no merit in the appeal which has been preferred against order dated 24.06.2010. Even according to the appellant, who was the petitioner before the learned single Judge, he was removed as a daily wager in the year 1999 and that removal was sought to be challenged in the year 2010 in the writ. Looking at the status of the appellant and the time frame between removal and the grievance raised, the learned single Judge did no wrong by dismissing the writ



application being devoid of merit.

Even the appeal has no merit. It is dismissed.
