ORAL ORDER

3 19-09-2017 The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with Gopalpur P.S. Case No. 65 of 2017, registered for offences punishable under Sections 279 and 304(A) of the Indian Penal Code and Section 37(b) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Prosecution case is that petitioner was driving a car in drunken state along with two other persons and dashed the wife and daughter of the informant resulting their death on the spot and petitioner and one co-accused succeeded in fleeing away from the spot, whereas one other co-accused was apprehended on spot, who disclosed the name of the petitioner as the driver.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that he has falsely been implicated in this case and has no criminal



antecedent and has been in judicial custody since 04.07.2017

Heard learned A.P.P. also.

Having heard both sides, considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also the fact that petitioner has no criminal antecedent, let the petitioner above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 25,000 (Rs. Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.D.J. -II, Gopalganj, in connection with Gopalpur P.S. Case No. 65 of 2017.

- (i) One of the bailors of the petitioner shall be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned Court.
- (ii) It is made clear that if the petitioner again found involved in any of the like offences, in future, prosecution will be free to move for cancellation of his bail bonds.
