ORAL ORDER

3 21-11-2017 Heard the parties.

The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with
s.T.No.112 1992 arising out of Bibhutipur P.S.Case no.37 of 1991
registered for offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 149,
242, 323, 324 and 436 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of
the Arms Act.

This is an application for misuse of privilege of bail.

Submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner is that
he has not misused the privilege of bail deliberately and he is
ready to abide by any condition imposed upon him.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.

Having heard both sides and in view of the facts and
circumstances, as stated above, let the petitioner, above named, be



enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Assistant Sessions Judge, Rosera, District Samastipur in connection with S.T.No.112 of 1992 arising out of Bibhutipur P.S.Case no.37 of 1991.

With following conditions :

- (i) One of the bailors of the petitioner shall be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned court.
- (ii) The petitioner will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence.
- (iii) The petitioner shall co-operate in the disposal of trial and make himself available as and when required by the court and in the event of failure to appear before the court below on two consecutive dates without showing any genuine reasons, the prosecution is free to move for cancellation of his bail bond.

With the aforesaid observation, this application is allowed.
