Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and State.

The petitioner is accused in Banmankhi (Jankinagar)

P.S.Case No. 76 of 2002 for the offences under Sections 395 of
the Indian Penal Code.

The FIR was lodged against unknown. The name of
the petitioner surfaced on the basis of the clue of the alleged
Guptchar. The date of alleged occurrence is 8.4.2002. The
statement on affidavit in para-3 of the petition is that the
petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Having regard to the fact that the instant case is of the
year 2002 and the petitioner, as per his statement on affidavit
made in para-3 of the petition, is a man of clean antecedent and
also considering the fact that other co-accused have been



acquitted in this case, let petitioner, above named, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Purnea or the successor Court in connection with Banmankhi (Jankinagar) P.S. Case No. 76 of 2002, subject to the condition that the petitioner will extend full cooperation in the conclusion of the trial and will not, in any manner, tamper with the evidence or influence the witnesses.
