2 19-09-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

The petitioner, who is in custody, seeks bail in connection with Chakia P.S. Case No. 57 of 2016 registered for the offence punishable under Section 414/34 and 11 (C) (I), 12 (a), (b), (C), (d) (e) of Prevention of Cruelty of Animal Act, 1960 and 47, 48, 49, 50 and 96 of the Exportation of Animal Act, 1978.

The allegation is that 16 cattle were recovered from the possession of the petitioner and other co-accused persons.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioner and he has got clean antecedent and he is in custody since 24.07.2017.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the



case, let the petitioner named above be released on bail upon
furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two
sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned 5th
Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Motihari, East Champaran,
in connection with Chakia P.S. Case No. 57 of 2016.
