2 11-08-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioners seek bail in Triveniganj P.S. Case
No. 197 of 2017 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468 and
379/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The petitioners along with other accused persons are
said to have introduced themselves as ornament cleaner and
grabbed the ornaments of the wife of the informant on the pretext
of cleaning the same free of cost. The petitioners were
apprehended after giving chase and two other accused persons
managed to escape.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners



that the looted article has been recovered from the conscious physical possession of the petitioners. Moreover, the case has been compromised between the parties.

The impugned order indicates that the substance meant for cleaning of the ornaments was recovered from the possession of the petitioners which goes to corroborate the prosecution case.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioners on bail at this stage. Accordingly, prayer for bail is rejected. However, the petitioners may renew their prayer for bail after four months or after framing of the charge whichever happens earlier.
