Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner is in custody in connection with Ghoshi P.S. Case No. 213 of 2016 for the offence under Section 394 of the Indian Penal Code.

The case was registered against unknown. The name of the petitioner figured in the instant case on the confessional statement of co-accused Prince Kumar. The statement in para 8 on affidavit stated that charge-sheet has been submitted against the petitioner, but up till now Test Identification Parade has not been conducted. The petitioner is languishing in jail since 20.09.2016.

Considering the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 20.09.2016 and he has not been put on T.I.P., let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like



amount each to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jehanabad in connection with Ghoshi P.S. Case No. 213 of 2016, subject to the condition that the petitioner will extend full cooperation in conclusion of the trial and will not, in any manner, tamper with the evidence and influence the witnesses. The trial court is directed to expedite the trial and conclude the same without granting any unnecessary adjournment to the parties.
