State.

Petitioner, already in custody, seeks bail in Simra
PS Case Nb. 18 of 2011 registered under Sections 109,
493, 366, 500 and 120(B) of the IPC

The allegation in brief is that the petitioner had
kidnapped the informant's daughter and returned after six
months but refused to marry her.

The submission is that the informant's daughter was
major when both of them eloped away and when the
petitioner refused to marry with her this false case has
been filed after a lapse of one year. The petitioner has
no criminal antecedent.

Having considered the said facts and circumstances,
the petitioner, namely, Deepak Kumar is directed to be
released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/-
(ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to
the satisfaction of CJM Aurangabad in connection with
Simra PS Case Nb. 18 of 2011.
