ORAL ORDER

4 25-08-2017 I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and
the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for offences punishable under Sections 30 (a)/36 of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

It is contended that, as per allegation, 1700 litres of foreign liquor were recovered from a pickup van. Petitioner claims to be the driver of the said vehicle. It is urged that the petitioner is in custody since 15.6.2017.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, the above named petitioner is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Special Judge, Excise Act, Patna in connection



with Special Case No. 2696/2017 arising out of Nadi P.S.
Case No. 41 of 2017.

If the petitioner, after his release in this case, is again
found involved in similar nature of cases then the concerned
court would be at liberty to take steps for cancellation of his
bail bonds.
