11 06-09-2017 Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, learned counsel for the State and also learned counsel for opposite party No.2.

Considering the fact that the parties have not settled their dispute amicably, this Court has no option but to dispose of the application with liberty to the petitioner to file appropriate application before the Court below. It is expected that the Court below will make all efforts for amicable settlement of dispute between husband and wife and refer the matter to the mediation centre at Gaya and in the event, the parties entered into compromise and resolve their dispute amicably and restore their normal conjugal life, the Court will record compromise and



dispose of the entire case on the basis of such compromise irrespective of the fact that the offence alleged is compoundable or not in view of the Judgment of the Hon'ble Apex Court reported in ***(2013)4 SCC 58 Jitendra Raghuvanshi Vs. Babita Raghuvanshi.***

With the aforesaid observation, the application stands disposed of.
