ORAL ORDER

2 15-11-017 Heard the parties.

The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with
govindganj (Malahi) P.S.Case No.166 of 2017, registered for
offences punishable under Section 387 of the Indian Penal Code
and Sections 4/5 of Explosive Substance Act,1908.

Allegation against the petitioner as per FIR is of demand of
extortion from the informant. The petitioner is not named in the
FIR and later on his name transpired during the course of
investigation of the case.

Submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner except
confession, there is nothing against the petitioner and other co-
accused persons having similar allegation has already been
granted bail by this Court, vide order dated 9.11.2017 passed in
Cr.Misc. No.52234 of 2017. The petitioner is in custody since
20.7.2017.



Heard learned A.P.P. also.

Having heard both sides and in view of the facts and circumstances, as stated above, let the petitioner, above named, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of A.C.J.M.-I, East Champaran, Motihari in connection with Govindganj (Malai) P.S.Case No.166 of 2017.

With following conditions :

- (i) One of the bailors of the petitioner shall be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned court.
- (ii) The petitioner will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence.
- (iii) The petitioner shall co-operate in the disposal of trial and make himself available as and when required by the court and in the event of failure to appear before the court below on two consecutive dates without showing any genuine reasons, the prosecution is free to move for cancellation of his bail bond.
- (iv) The petitioner shall appear before the police in the first week of every month of his area for a period of two years, so that the police may watch his conduct, otherwise his bail bond shall be cancelled.

With the aforesaid observation, this application is allowed.
