2 21-12-2017 Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the

learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with Rail
Gaya P.S. Case No. 312 of 2017 instituted for the offences under
Section 30(A) of the Excise Act, 2016.

The allegation is regarding recovery of 40 litres of illicit
country made liquor from the compartment of the railway bogie in
which the petitioner is said to be a co-passenger.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner was sitting in the same compartment from which the
alleged recovery has been made. However, he has got nothing to
do with the same and he has been falsely implicated in the present
case. It is further submitted that the petitioner has a fair antecedent
and he is in custody since 07.10.2017.



Considering the nature of accusation, the period of custody already undergone and the fact that the petitioner has got a clean antecedent, I direct the petitioner named above to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Special Judge, Excise, Gaya in connection with Rail Gaya P.S. Case No. 312 of 2017.
