ORAL ORDER

2 20-12-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP
for the State.

The petitioner wants to renew his prayer of bail, which was earlier rejected vide order dated 15.03.2017 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 3319 of 2017, on the ground that the petitioner is in custody since 28.09.2016 and up-till now only two prosecution witnesses have been examined and in near future the trial is not likely to be concluded. Other co-accused have been allowed pre-arrest bail and the petitioner is the husband and is suffering in custody.

Learned APP opposes the prayer of bail by submitting that the trial is going on and in near future it is likely to be concluded.

In the facts and circumstances stated above, at present, finding no good ground for reconsideration of the prayer of bail



of the petitioner, again his such prayer stands rejected in S. Tr.
No. 360 of 2017 / 117 of 2017 pending in the court of learned
Additional Sessions Judge-I, Aurangabad.

However, learned trial court is directed to expedite the trial
and conclude the same as early as possible, preferably within six
months from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this
order, failing which, the petitioner, if at no fault, may be at
liberty to renew his prayer of bail.
