Considering the fact that the learned writ Court has
relegated the petitioner to take recourse to the remedy of statutory



appeal available to him under Section 14 of the Bihar Land Disputes Resolution Act, 2009. The petitioner can ventilate his claim by filing appeal. If the appeal is filed by the petitioner within a period of 30 days, the appellate authority shall decide the appeal within a period of six months.

We see no merit in the appeal, it is, accordingly, dismissed.
