Heard learned counsel for the parties.

In the present case, the petitioner is challenging the order dated 1.1.2015 passed by District Magistrate, Gaya in Supply Appeal Case No. 05 of 2014, whereby and whereunder, the appeal, filed by the petitioner, has been dismissed.

From the order of the appellate authority, it appears that for consecutive three days, the petitioner had remained absent. Having no other way out, the appellate authority passed the impugned order.

The petitioner, if so advised, may file revision application.

If the petitioner files a revision application, the Revisional Commissioner will dispose of the same within a period of six months
