Petitioner apprehends arrest in connection with

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the

dispute is purely civil in nature for that criminal prosecution is

not warranted. Petitioner is still ready to make payment of the

Learned Addl. P.P. appearing for the State opposes

the prayer for bail and submits that there is specific allegation



against this petitioner. Matter was referred to the Mediation Centre but the same failed.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions advanced on behalf of the parties, I do not feel inclined to grant the privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. His prayer for anticipatory bail is, therefore, rejected.
