Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the
State.

The petitioners seek bail in a case registered for
offences under Sections 30 (A) of the Bihar Prohibition
and Excise Act, 2016.

It is contended that, as per allegation, 20.40 litres
of Nepali Soufi Wine was recovered from the two bags
which was being carried by the petitioners. Petitioners
claim that they are having clean antecedent and are in
custody since 17.08.2017.



Considering the facts and the circumstances of the case, the petitioners, above named, are directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Additional Sessions Judge-II-cum-Special Judge, Excise Act, Sitamarhi in connection with Mejorganj P.S. Case No. 341 of 2017 with a condition that if the petitioner, after his release in this case, is again found to be involved in criminal case of similar nature, the court concerned would be at liberty to take steps for cancellation of his bail bonds.
