In the matter of payment of subsistence allowance to the appellant and for regularizing the period of suspension after completion of the Departmental Enquiry, learned Writ Court has already directed the competent authority to pass appropriate orders under Rule 97(3) of the Bihar Service Code, and this being the only direction that could be issued after the punishment imposed to the appellant is found to be proper. No further indulgence



into the matter is called for.

Accordingly, the appeal stands disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to pass appropriate orders on the application if any filed by the appellant under Rule 97(3) of the Bihar Service Code within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of the order.

With the aforesaid, the appeal stands disposed of.
