Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Learned counsel for the respondents have raised preliminary objection about the maintainability of the writ application in view of the decision of the Full Bench passed in ***Organizer, Dehri C.D. & C.M. Union Limited vs. The State of Bihar & Ors.*** reported in ***2014(1) PLJR 695***, where the Court has held that the writ is not maintainable against the co-operative society.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has approached before the Registrar, Co-



operative Society.

In such view of the matter, this writ application is not maintainable. Accordingly, this writ application is dismissed. However, the Registrar, Co-operative Society will be obliged to look into the grievance of the petitioner and take decision in accordance with law without unnecessary delay.
