The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had taken lift in the said car and he is neither the driver nor the owner. It is further submitted that he has clean



antecedent and he is in custody since 09.09.2017.

Considering the nature of accusation, clean antecedent and the period of custody undergone, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of 2nd Addl. Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge (Excise), Samastipur in connection with N.H. Bangara PS case no. 83 of 2017.
