2 17-11-2017 Heard the parties.

The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with
Bibhutipur P.S.Case No.179 of 2017 registered for offences
punishable under Sections 272,273 and 414 of the Indian Penal
Code and Section 38, 47 and 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and
Excise Act, 2016.

Allegation against the petitioner is about recovery of 81 ltrs.
of liquor from the motorcycle. He has been arrested on the spot.

Submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner is that
he has been falsely implicated in this case and nothing has been
recovered from his possession and it has also been submitted that
several persons have been arrested. Another co-accused has been
granted bail by this Court vide order dated 13.10.2017 passed in



Cr. Misc. No.49050 of 2017. He is in custody since 24.8.2017.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.

Having heard both sides and in view of the facts and circumstances, as stated above, let the petitioner, above named, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional District and Sessions Judge-II, Samastipur in connection with Bibhutipur P.S.Case No.179 of 2017 dated 22.8.2017.

With following conditions :

- (i) One of the bailors of the petitioner shall be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned court.
- (ii) The petitioner will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence.
- (iii) The petitioner shall co-operate in the disposal of trial and make himself available as and when required by the court and in the event of failure to appear before the court below on two consecutive dates without showing any genuine reasons, the prosecution is free to move for cancellation of his bail bond.

With the aforesaid observation, this application is allowed.
