Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and State.

2. It is an admitted position that substantial post retiral
dues have been paid.

3. However, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted
that he is an old man and has communicated that there are still some
dues remaining.

4. In view of the aforesaid, the writ petition stands
disposed off with liberty to the petitioner to file a representation
before the respondent no. 2 with regard to any of his remaining



grievances. If such representation is filed within one month from today along with a copy of this order, the same shall be considered and disposed off by passing reasoned order within the next four months. If any amount is found payable to the petitioner, the same shall also be paid to him within the next four weeks.
