ORAL ORDER

2 15-11-2017 Earlier, prayer of bail of the petitioner was rejected vide order dated 24.07.2017 by this Court passed in Criminal Miscellaneous No. 30550 of 2017 with observation that the petitioner may renew his prayer for bail in the court below itself, after framing of charge in this case.

Submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner is that charge has been framed and not a single prosecution witness has been examined. There is no specific allegation against him. He is in custody since 03.02.2017.

Heard learned APP also.

Having heard both sides and in view of facts and circumstances, as stated above, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees



twenty five thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Session's Judge, Jamui in connection with Khaira P.S. Case No. 26 of 2017, subject to the conditions as follows:

- (1) One of the bailors shall be a local person having sufficient immovable properties within the jurisdiction of the court concerned.
- (2) Petitioner will mark his attendance in local station in first week of every month at least for one year so that police may watch his conduct during the said period, failing which his bail bond shall be cancelled.
- (3) The petitioner shall cooperate in the disposal of trial and make himself available as and when required by the court and on the event of failure on his part to appear before the court below on two consecutive dates without showing any genuine reasons, the prosecution will be free



to move for cancellation of his bail
bonds.
