A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for offences punishable under Section 30 (a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

It is contended that, as per allegation, 32 bottles (each containing 180 ml.), 8 bottles (each containing 180 ml.), one bottle (containing 750 ml.), 42 bottles (each containing 375 ml.) and 48 bottles (each containing 180 ml.) foreign liquor were recovered from the rented house of the petitioner. It is further contended that the recovered wine belonged to other three accused persons and petitioner was only watching the place where the seized wine was kept. Petitioner claims that he is having clean antecedent and is in custody since 19.08.2017, i.e.,



more than three months.

Having regard to the facts and the circumstances of the case, the abovenamed petitioner is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Addl. Sessions Judge, VII-cum-Special Judge, Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016, Begusarai in connection with Birpur P.S. Case No. 101 /2017.

Further, if the petitioner, after his release in this case, is again found to be involved in similar nature of case then the court concerned would be at liberty to take steps for cancellation of his bail bond.
