2 23-11-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the
State.

The petitioners seek bail in a case registered for offences under Section 30 (A) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

It is contended that, as per allegation, 78 litres of Nepali Soufi Wine was recovered from the tempo which was being boarded by the petitioners. It is urged that the petitioners have remained in custody since 03.10.2017. It is



claimed that the petitioners are having clean antecedent.

Considering the facts and the circumstances of the case, the petitioners, above named, are directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Additional Sessions Judge-II-cum-Special Judge, Excise Act, Sitamarhi in connection with Majorganj P.S. Case No. 413 of 2017 with a condition that if the petitioners, after their release in this case, are again found to be involved in criminal case of similar nature, the court concerned would be at liberty to take steps for cancellation of their bail bonds.
