Considering the fact that appellant has not been appointed to the service in question based on the examination of height conducted by a duly constituted committee and now when the Writ Court have found that the appellant did not fulfill the height criteria and in the re-examination done by the competent authority, the appellant did not fulfill the requirement of having a specific height, we see no reason to make any indulgence into the matter.

The criteria for fulfilling the height having been examined by a duly constituted committee of experts, no further



direction for any examination can be issued now in this appeal.

The appeal is, therefore, dismissed.
