Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

This application, for grant of anticipatory bail, arises
out of Ramgarh Police Station Case No. 121 of 2017, disclosing
offences under Sections 414 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that
the petitioner is innocent and has not committed any offence. In
fact, the petitioner has been made accused on the basis of
confessional statement of the co-accused. Nothing has been
recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner.
Hence, the petitioner deserves the privilege of anticipatory bail..

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case,
let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or



surrender before the Court below within six weeks, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kaimur at Bhabua, in connection with Ramgarh Police Station Case No. 121 of 2017, subject to the condition laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
