ORAL ORDER

2 23-02-2017 In view of the judgment of a Special Bench of this

Court in ***The Organizer, Dehri C.D. & C.M. Union Limited. Vs.***
The State of Bihar & Ors. [2014 (1) PLJR 695], the writ
application against a Co-operative Society is not maintainable if
the affairs of the Society is managed by the Board of Directors. If
the Society is under suppression and an Administrator/Special
Officer is appointed by the State to manage the affairs of the
Society then only the writ application would be maintainable
against the action taken by the Administrator/Special Officer.



It is not the case of the petitioner that the Society in question is superseded and is being run by the Administrator/ Special Officer.

In that view of the matter, the instant writ application is dismissed as not maintainable.
