been examined.

That being so, now the ball has gone to the court of
the accused-petitioner. In the aforesaid eventuality, learned lower
court is directed to conclude the trial within four months in case
there happens to be active co-operation at the end of the
petitioner..

reconsider the plea of the petitioner. Consequent thereupon, the instant petition is rejected.
