2 16-05-2017 Heard learned counsel, Mr. Abhishek Kumar, for the

petitioner and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

 This application, for grant of anticipatory bail, arises

out of Kessariya Police Station Case No. 190 of 2016, disclosing

offences under Sections 382, 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

 Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that

the petitioner has not been named in the F.I.R. and merely on the

basis of confession, the petitioner has been made accused in this

case. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession

of the petitioner. The petitioner, who is of clean antecedent, has

no concern with the alleged recovery. Hence, the petitioner

deserves the privilege of anticipatory bail.



Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within six weeks, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned 11th Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Motihari, East Champaran in connection with Kessariya Police Station Case No. 190 of 2016, subject to the condition laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
