ORAL ORDER

2 17-02-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 149, 323, 341, 354, 379, 504, 506 and 308 of the Indian Penal Code.

For land dispute, the petitioners, allegedly, committed assault, theft and attempt to outrage the modesty of the informant.

Considering the background and nature of allegation, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or



surrender before the Court below within a period of thirty days from the date of receipt of the order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-IV, Buxar/Successor Court in connection with Simri Police Station Case No. 209 of 2016, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
