ORAL ORDER

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
ya P.S. Case No. 409 of 2015, registered under
4(B) and 201/34 of the Indian Penal Code, pending in
the S.D.J.M. (West) Muzaffarpur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is happens to be the husband of the deceased, daughter of the informant, and he has falsely been implicated in this case.



Further submission is that, in fact, deceased died due to complications in the pregnancy, but with ulterior motive the informant, who is father of the deceased, has lodged this case, but after realizing his mistakes, he filed an application in the Court S.D.J.M. West Muzaffarpur on 21.12.2017 saying that cause of death was complication in the pregnancy.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case and the nature of allegation against the petitioner, I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, his prayer for grant of anticipatory bail stands rejected. The petitioner is directed to surrender before the trial Court within four weeks and pray for regular bail, which would be considered by the trial Court in accordance with law without being prejudiced by the order of this Court.
