ORAL ORDER

2 16-01-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the

learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is in custody since 9.9.2016 in
connection with Chhauradano P.S. Case No.195 of 2015
registered for the offence under Sections 467, 468, 471, 419
and 420 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
though there is an allegation against the petitioner that no
sooner did the Bank authority demand the money, he had
returned the entire money. The said fact is evident from the
F.I.R. itself.



In view of the fact that the money has now been refunded and that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on his furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Raxaul, Motihari, in connection with Chhauradano P.S. Case No.195 of 2015.
