3 18-01-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as
learned Addl. Public Prosecutor.

The application is for grant of bail in connection
with NDPS case no. 42 of 2016 for the offence under Sections
47(a) Excise Act and 20(b) of NDPS Act.

It is submitted on behalf of petitioner that from
perusal of seizure list, it appears that seizure is not from the shop
of the petitioner rather it is from an open place and petitioner has
been implicated in this case due to enmity.

Heard learned A.P.P. also. Learned A.P.P. has
opposed the prayer for bail stating that seizure list itself shows that
recovery is from behind the *pan* shop of the petitioner and apart
from that, 500 gms *charas* has also been recovered.

Having heard both sides. In view of recovery of



500 gms of *charas* in this case and that too behind the *pan* shop of the petitioner, I am not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. As such, his prayer for bail rejected at this stage.
