2 17-03-2017 Heard learned Counsel for the petitioner and learned Additional Public Prosecutor representing the State.

The Opposite Party Nos. 2 to 4 have been allowed anticipatory bail by the Court of learned Sessions Judge, Gaya, by order, dated 02.09.2016, passed in A.B.P. No. 2364 of 2016, in connection with Gaya Mufassil Police Station Case No. 244 of 20165, registered for the offence punishable under Section 498A/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 3/4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.



The Opposite Party No. 2 is father-in-law of the petitioner, Opposite Party No. 3 is mother-in-law of the petitioner and Opposite Party No. 4 is brother of the husband of the petitioner.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that they obtained privilege of anticipatory bail on the basis of wrong submission that the parties were making attempts to get the dispute resolved.

However, considering the nature of case and relationship of the opposite parties with the petitioner, the order granting anticipatory bail cannot be said to be unjustified.

This application has no merit and is accordingly dismissed.
