detected that Rajendra Prasad Yadav @ Rajendra Rai, the then In-Charge Branch Manager of the said bank, Amod Kumar, Contract Clerk (Petitioner) and Hirakant Thakur, Cashier withdrew the said amount.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was the Contract Clerk and when he came to know about misappropriation of money through different accounts of the bank, he deposited Rs. 10,00,000/- in the account of said Dipak Kumar.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case and the nature of allegation against the petitioner, I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, his prayer for grant of anticipatory bail stands rejected. The petitioner is directed to surrender before the trial Court within four weeks and pray for regular bail, which would be considered by the trial Court in accordance with law without being prejudiced by the order of this Court.
