Concurrent orders passed by the Collector, the Commissioner and the Writ Court in the matter of terminating the engagement of the appellant in an Anganwari Centre as a Sevika is challenged in this appeal under Clause 10 of the Letters Patent and the learned Writ Court has found that the conduct of the appellant shows that she was not interested in working, the consistent findings recorded by the Collector and the Commissioner in the matter does not call for any interference in the matter of disengaging an Anganwari Sevika. The concurrent orders passed holding that the



appellant was not interested to work is a finding of fact and we see no reason to make any indulgence into the matter.

The Letters Patent Appeal is dismissed.
