ORAL ORDER

3 27-04-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with Kopa P.S. Case No. 127 of 2016 registered under Sections 363 and 366(A) of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that it would appear from Annexure-2 that father-in-law of the petitioner has filed a Complaint against the informant and others for kidnapping of his son Sanjay Kumar before filing of this case. Thereafter, petitioner, brother-in-law of Sanjay Kumar, who has falsely been implicated in this case. He has no concern with Sanjay Kumar, Branch Manager, Micro Finance Bank.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the



case, let the above named petitioner be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the C.J.M., Saran at Chapra in connection with Kopa P.S. Case No. 127 of 2016, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
