Mr. R.K.Mahajan, Principal Secretary, Education,
states that financial benefits pertaining to grant of A.C.P. and arrears
have been ordered to be paid and will be paid within one week.

It is further pointed out that the petitioner has since
attained the age of superannuation but the petitioner has not
submitted her service book and pension papers which continue to be
in her possession. It is stated that as and when service book and
pension papers are submitted, the State shall process the same in
accordance with law expeditiously.



In view of the said fact, no further orders are called for in the present contempt petition. The same is disposed of.

However, liberty is given to the petitioner to submit representation in respect of any other subsisting grievance, which shall be considered by the respondents in accordance with law.
