3      17-03-2017                      Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned  
counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection  
with Basantpur P.S. Case No. 174 of 2016 for the offences  
instituted under Sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 342, 323, 324, 308  
and 302 of the Indian Penal Code.

The allegation against the petitioner is of committing  
assault upon Wakil Yadav by means of knife, causing injury on  
his left leg.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the  
petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. There is no allegation  
of tampering of witnesses alleged against the petitioner. The  
petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case. There is  
no allegation of assault upon the deceased by the petitioner. The



petitioner is said to have caused injury upon Wakil Yadav on the non-vital part of the body. The nature of injury is said to be simple.

On behalf of the State, it has been submitted that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner above named be released on anticipatory bail in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of six weeks from today in connection with Basantpur P.S. Case No. 174 of 2016 on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned C.J.M., Siwan, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
